About Young Citizens

Young Citizens helps young people become active, engaged and motivated citizens, who are able to contribute positively to their communities – whether those communities are local, national or global.

We believe that by helping young people play a full part in their communities, we can help strengthen democratic society. At a time when so many of our democratic institutions are under threat, our work is more important than ever.

Our work ranges from immersive learning projects where young people learn about the legal justice system to empowering children to take action on social issues they care about most. We also empower teachers and volunteering professionals with specialist training and resources for classroom delivery. All of our work has a single aim: to help young people be active citizens for life.

About Economic Experts in Schools

Economic Experts in Schools partners professionals with groups of young people to help them to understand the basics of economics and see how a changing economic climate impacts them and the world they live in. This delivery model allows volunteers to have a positive impact on key employability skills and raises the aspirations of the students involved.

Over 3, 1 hour sessions professionals work with small groups of students, aged 14-15. Using specially created resources looking at subjects such as economic cycles and taxation, they generate discussion and debate about the economy. This programme not only helps young people to learn basic economic terms and concepts, but it also gives them the unique opportunity to interact and work closely with professionals.

Economic Experts in Schools has been running since 2012, giving young people rare access to the financial profession and the opportunity to learn about the economic implications of current events from the very people who assess these daily. It's a truly rewarding volunteering experience for professionals which makes a real difference to the young people who take part.



Economic Experts in Schools is an award winning programme which was first created in partnership with FTI Consulting. Since then the programme has been opened up to other businesses to improve the economic literacy of young people across the UK.
